GOTHA URSINUS G I

The Gotha G series of bombers were the main German twin-engine bombers of World War I.

Built by Gothaer Waggonfabrik, the first unsuccessful variant was the Gotha G I. It had an unusual shape, with a fuselage upon the upper wing of the biplane, and only a small number were built. The next Gotha planes were completely different from type Gotha G I, and were similar to each other, the main difference being in the engines used.

The first plane type Gotha G I were built in Juli 1915. In April 1915 the Gothaer Waggonfabrick built prototype Gotha UWD -two-floatsplane the TROJAN HORSE, number German Navy 120..
