T2485 PANDA was a Light Tank Mk VIIB of 1st Life & Forfar Yeomanry in the BEF 1940. Other animal names were used at this time including PUMA and TERRIER. She is shown in a dark green G4 over middle green G3 MTP20 scheme, with a rather roughly-applied white on black GHQ AOS 117 front and rear (1FFY were the GHQ reserve armoured regiment), and also the BEF white recognition squares on all four sides of the hull.

Below: This Ferret Scout Car Mk 2 08BB65 was operated by 17 Troop, C Squadron, ARTR in the Aden area 1963. The white air recognition band is applied over the rear of the hull with tyre pressure markings on the wings, but the rest of the markings reflect the unit – blue circle on the turret, the troop pennant, and of course the Chinese Eyes on the front of the hull. Note that although the vehicle is in Light Stone overall, the wheel hubs and the inside of the wheel arches remain in DBG. Unusually for ARTR, she does not appear to carry a name.
