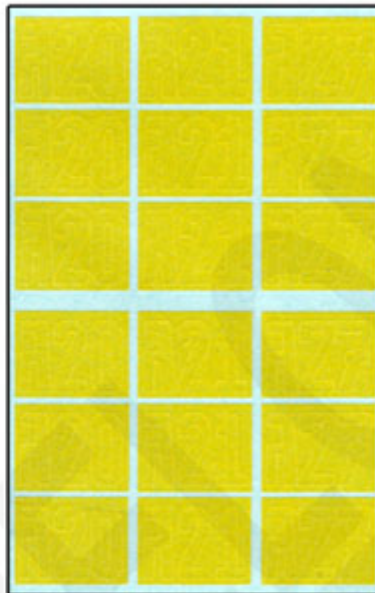

**1** Panel already painted in base colour.

**2** Using tweezers, gently apply mask from B section.

**3** Spray white colour.

**4** Apply respective masks from B section. Be sure to anchor the masks towards the bottom left corner of A section mask. There should be open gaps on the top and right edge.

**5** Spray black colour.

**6** Peel off all masks and clean the paper. The result should be as shown.

*Note: A Section masks are specifically catered for the black shadow part of the tactical markings. If shadows are not wanted, use B section masks instead.*

*This is an instruction for typical white with black shadow tactical markings. If creating white-only or black-only markings, just use masks from B section and follow through steps 1 to 3 and spray the appropriate colour.*

*Anchor B section masks towards this corner.*

*There should be gaps here for black shadows to be sprayed on.*

## IDF Turret Tactical Markings (Set 6)

### PAINT MASK

A20	A21	A27	White with black shadows (A - 8 masks)
A20	A21	A27	White (B masks)
A20	A21	A27	Black (B masks)

**KABUKI MASKS**  
Enough masks to cover all 3 sides of the turret for each set of marking. The styles are capture from latest Merkava tanks most of which have very standard set of markings.

Paint masks allow realistic washed out faded tactical markings that wear on some surfaces and are more realistic in appearance.

This set allows 3 variations of tactical markings: white with black offset shadows, solid white, and solid black.

The rectangle shape of each mask fits the panel size, which is 17 x 13mm (approx).

A pair of tweezers are recommended for careful handling of each mask.

Use an air-brush to spray paint onto the masks. Other methods of painting may destroy the soft masks.
