Various markings seen on the RPG-shields:



No Squadron/Tramp markings visible on the photo.

Possible had a Deep Bronze Green with hard edge Black camo.



The position of the star could differ, also the size, and sometimes it was overpainted.



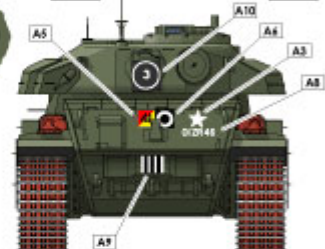
Hard edge Black disruptive camo. Also on the turret and hull.

Some minor differences in the design of the markings can be seen.

Shipping markings. Seems to have been hand painted in white, on the first section of the RPG-shields. All kind of styles and sizes. Usually impossible to see full number.



Some KRHH tanks have the star painted on the turret roof.

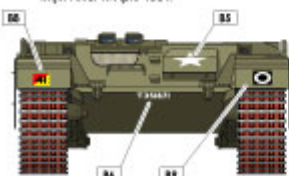


The Sigs-markings on the rear, were painted on a metalplate, fastened to the rear of the turret.

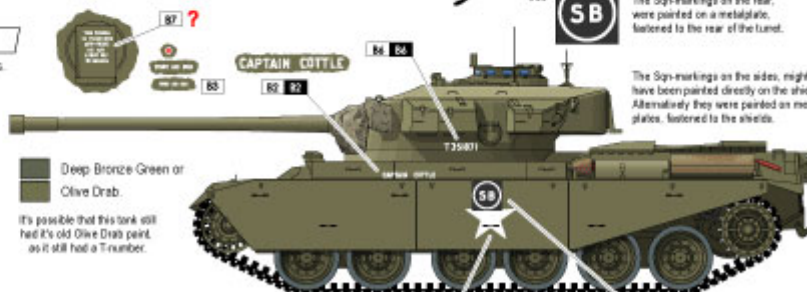
The Sigs-markings on the sides, might have been painted directly on the shields. Alternatively they were painted on metal plates, fastened to the shields.

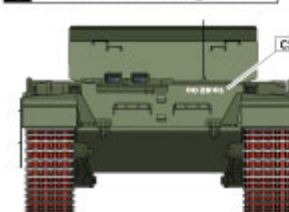


Deep Bronze Green or Olive Drab.
