Various markings seen on the RPG-shields:

No Squadron/ Troop markings visible on the photo.

Possible had a Deep Bronze Green with hard edge black camo.

The position of the star could differ, also the size, and sometimes it was overpainted.

Hard edge Black disruptive camo. Also on the turret and hull.

Some minor differences in the design of the markings can be seen.

Shipping markings. Seems to have been hand painted in white, on the first section of the RPG-shields. All kind of styles and sizes. Usually impossible to see full number.
