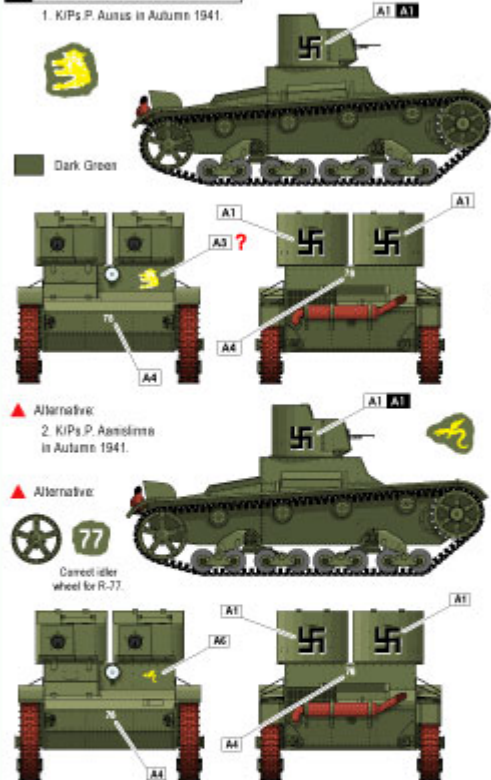

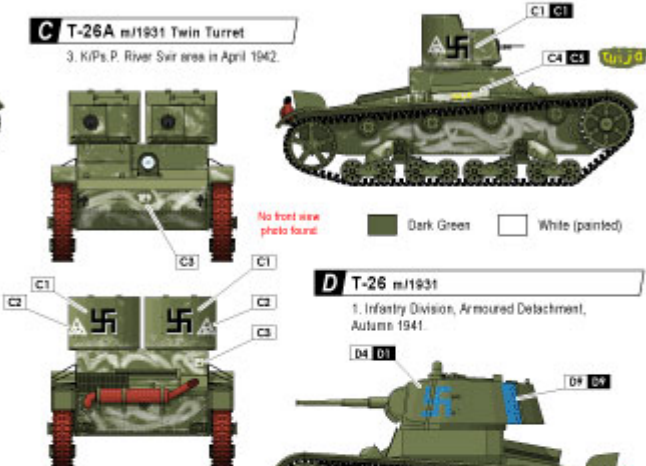

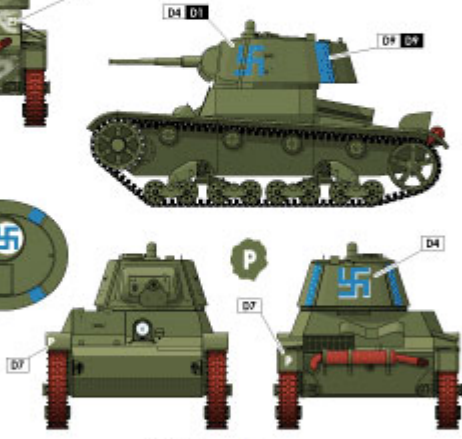

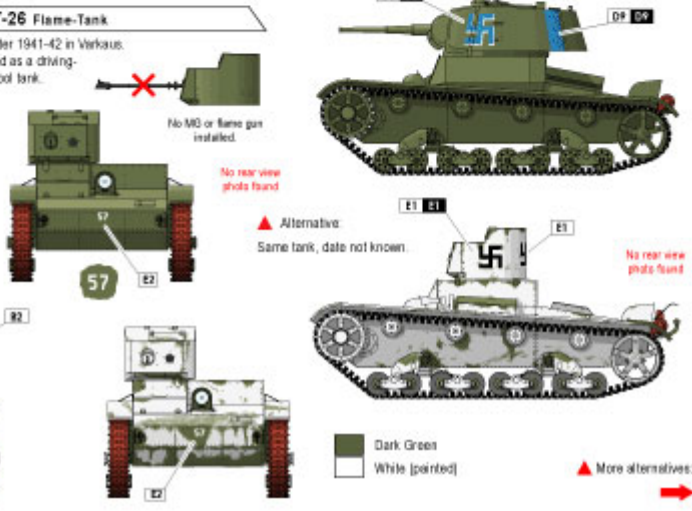

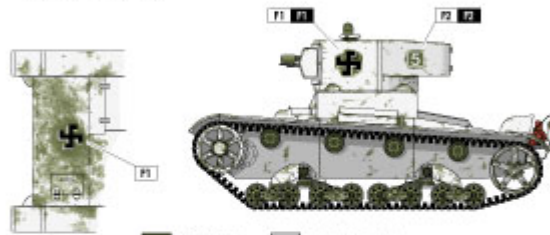

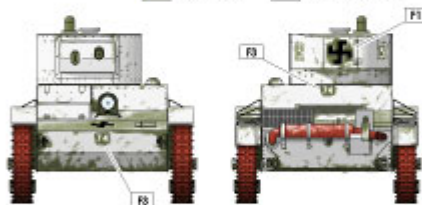

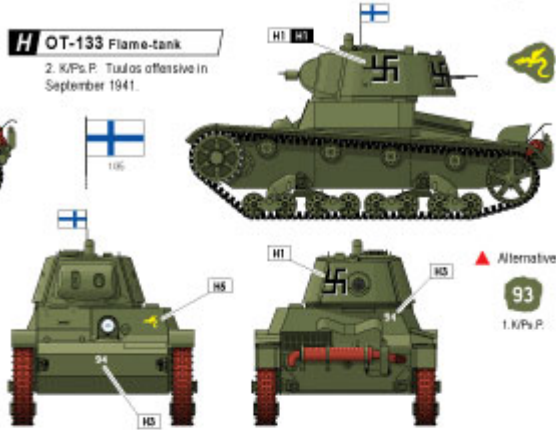

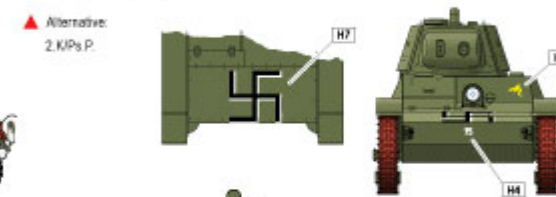

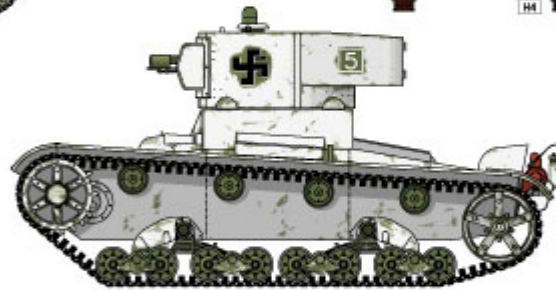
2. KIPs P. Tuulos offensive in

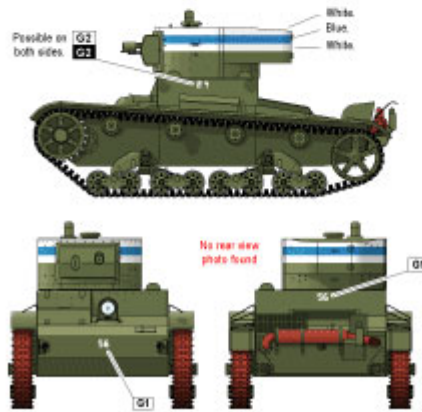
