Standard colours of Soviet planes from mid-1943 till end of war

La-7, 'white 40', 111th GvIAP (Guards Fighter Air Regiment), Rajbor (currently Racibórz, Poland), April 1945



Il-2m3, 'yellow 40', 59th GvShAP (Guards Ground Attack Air Regiment), Germany, May 1945



Yak-9T, 'white 52', 812th "Sevastopol" IAP (Fighter Air Regiment), April 1944

Used for upper surfaces in grey-grey and grey-brown-green schemes of late war fighters and ground attack planes

Used for upper surfaces in grey/black-brown-green schemes of ground attack planes (incl. Il-2, Pe-2, Il-10, Pe-2, Pe-8, Il-4)

Used for upper surfaces in grey-grey camouflage of fighter planes, including Yak-1b/3/7b/9, LaGG-3, La-5F/FN and La-7

Used for upper surfaces in grey/black-brown-green schemes of 'metal' ground attack planes (incl. Il-10, Pe-2, Tu-2, Pe-8, Il-4)

Used for lower surfaces in camouflage schemes of majority of Soviet fighters and ground attack planes since mid-1943 till end of war

Used in black-brown-green schemes of ground attack planes (incl. Pe-8, Il-4), also on undersurfaces of night bombers

According to the instruction issued in July 1943, a new painting schemes were introduced onto Soviet warplanes: the upper and side surfaces of all fighter aircraft were to be painted in Dark Grey / Blue Grey pattern, while all other types of aircraft wore Camouflage Green / Light Greyish Brown / Dark Grey scheme (the latter replaced with Black on Il-4s and Pe-8s). Lower surfaces of all late war period aircraft were to be painted with a Greyish Blue colour, with the exception of night bombers, which used Black paint instead.
