This German WWII self-propelled gun – whose name translates to “bumblebee” – now joins the 1/35 Military Miniature Series.

The Hummel was designed to fulfil demand for mobile artillery support for German tank units. Based upon the Geschützwagen III/IV (also used on the Nashorn), it sported an L/30 15cm howitzer and open top fighting compartment. Hummels were designed in 1942 and debuted on the Eastern Front in 1943; they were also seen in North-West Europe and Italy in latter half of WWII.
