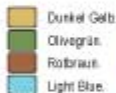

Alternative:

The StuGs used by the Mechanized Training Centre in Targoviste, and the 1st Tank Training Centre in Doibov, remained in their German colours and original markings.

Romanian tanks should have been marked with white StMichael crosses in 1943-44, but it's not known if the StuGs had them, or if the old German crosses still were visible.

Not known if any registration number was used of the rear.

The colour of the star used by the StuGs are not known. Different sources gives different answers. The PzIVs from this unit had Khaki coloured stars.

On the photos without side skirts the original German crosses is visible. Not known if this StuG had them.

C StuG III Ausf G - Late

7th Assault Gun Battalion, 1944-45

The third number on this StuG are missing on both sides, as seen on photos, but as the Hungarian StuGs were numbered from 700 to 731, it should have been either '0' or an '1'. On the front this StuG seems to have what might be a cross painted on the lower hull.

It is possible that this StuG actually was painted with White-wash, or at least the remains of it are seen on the photo, as it looks rather white. During the winter 1944-45 the Hungarian StuGs was camouflaged with white paint.



Some StuG photographed at an earlier date in 1944. No white-wash applied. Third number overpainted.

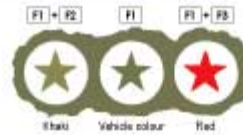

Khaki or possible Dark Green.

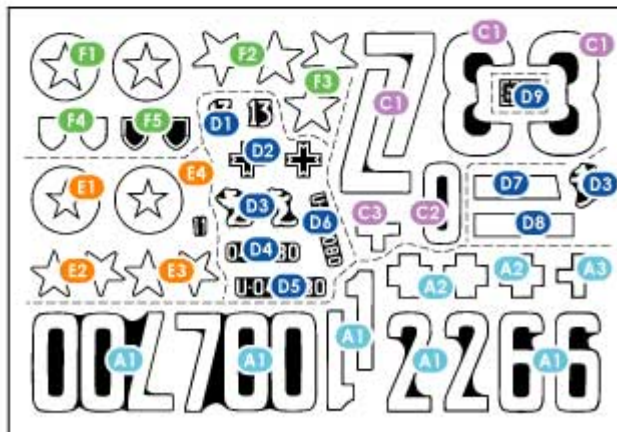


On the sides are the insignia of a German unit that have captured this vehicle somewhere in Czechoslovakia. Sadly the inside of the insignia are obscured on the reference photo. I've added the "Zahn" insignia. Identified as Pz. Reg. 9. 25. Pz.Div. This StuG is loaded on a railroad wagon and a Pz II is loaded in front of it seems to have that insignia. But no proof of this...
